NOAC is Scouting's second-largest national program event. The reason for its growing popularity can be attributed to the fact that it is planned and carried out by Arrowmen themselves. Youth involvement ensures that the conference program will be exciting, relevant, and non-stop fun. These gatherings normally draw over 10,000 Arrowmen, traveling from the whole country, for five days of training, fun, and fellowship. With each conference, NOAC becomes more diverse, more fun, and more exciting. NOAC has many different aspects making it impossible to participate in every event. Each year events are added and changed so you could go to NOAC every time and do new things each time. The main activities at NOAC include training, ceremonies evaluation, American Indian events, shows, competitions and Founder's Day. NOAC has something for everyone of all backgrounds and all ages. It is one of Scouting's most unique and entertaining training events. The 2020 NOAC will be held at Michigan State University, in East Lansing, Michigan from August 3rd to August 8th, 2020. Our Lodge will be leaving on August 2nd, 2020 and returning late on August 8th, 2020. An overnight stop is planned during the trip to Michigan. Final travel arrangements, including departure points will be confirmed in 2020 and may be adjusted prior to departure depending on the number of participants from Lodge 104. An estimated \$500 per youth if changes occur, these are the same prices as Occoneechee Lodge 104 set in 2018 for NOAC 2018. An estimated 10,000 Arrowmen from across the nation will convene at MSU for the for the second NOAC in the second century of the Order of the Arrow.
