Motion Passed:

Daniel Salgado moves to approve a sash design to be worn for additional recognition of Elangomats at future Ordeals.

**This is a brand new type of recognitions for our elangomats. This idea spawned from visiting the Tutelo lodge back in September. WE have designed a special red sash with white embroidery for our elangomats to wear while they serve during the ordeal weekend. Be sure to volunteer in March (Yes, there will be an ordeal in March, see below), May or September as an elangomat!**

Motion Passed:

Brandon Kelly move to change the wording on Page B-11, Article V, Section 1, is changed in Paragraph 5 to read, "The third weekend for events is determined by the third Saturday of the month; Weekend events will begin on the Friday immediately preceding the third Saturday and end on Sunday."

**This is a subtle change in the planbook that will clear up any confusion regarding when we schedule lodge events. We will schedule lodge events on the third weekend of the month, more specifically, going by the third Saturday of the month. For example, if the month starts on a Sunday, then that will not count as first weekend of the month.**

Motion Passed:

Daniel Salgado moves to add an Ordeal to Spring Pow Wow 2013.
