National Order of the Arrow Conference

Every three years, Arrowmen from across the country gather on the campus of a major university for the National Order of the Arrow Conference (NOAC).

NOAC is Scouting's second-largest national program event. The reason for its growing popularity can be attributed to the fact that it is planned and carried out by Arrowmen themselves. Youth involvement ensures that the conference program will be exciting, relevant, and non-stop fun.

These gatherings normally draw over 8,000 Arrowmen, traveling from as far away as Europe and Asia, for five days of training, fun, and fellowship. With each conference, NOAC becomes more diverse, more fun, and more exciting.

NOAC has many different aspects making it impossible to participate in every event. Each year events are added and changed so you could go to NOAC every time and do new things each time. The main activities at NOAC include training, ceremonies evaluation, American Indian events, shows, competitions and Founder's Day. NOAC has something for everyone of all backgrounds and all ages. It is definitely one of Scouting's most unique and entertaining training events.

The 2015 NOAC will be held at Michigan State University in East Lansing, Michigan, from August 3rd to August 8th 2015.

Our Lodge will be leaving on August 2nd 2015 and returning late on August 8th 2015. An overnight stop is planned during the trip to Michigan. Final travel arrangements, including departure points will be confirmed in 2015 and may be adjusted prior to departure depending on the number of participants from Lodge 104.

I understand that the Contingent fees are \$775/Arrowman which include NOAC registration, transportation to the event, 1 nights lodging prior to the event, all meals during the Conference, selected meals while travelling and Contingent spirit items as determined by the Lodge NOAC Committee.

As a member of the Order of the Arrow and wanting to attend the 2015 NOAC, I will do the following:

1. Attend all contingent meetings for NOAC 2015 which will be held during regular Lodge weekends or as otherwise scheduled prior to departure.
2. Pay the Fee presented by the Lodge which is not refundable, but fully transferrable to another person. If I am unable to attend NOAC, I understand that it is my responsibility to find a replacement for my registration or forfeit
3. I will attend all evening shows with the Lodge Contingent and wear the uniform indicated by the Contingent Leadership.
4. I will not leave the MSU campus without the expressed consent of the Contingent Leadership.
5. I will be in the dorm by our curfew.
6. I will obey all NOAC 2015 and Lodge Rules; I will set the example as a proper Arrowman and be a representative of our Lodge. I will follow all instructions given to me by the Contingent leadership.
7. I will follow the priorities of activities set by the group and stay with the plan.
8. I will participate in the Founder's Day Activities and assist as requested.
9. I will show Lodge Spirit by participating actively in all events.
10. If I am 18 years of age or older while at NOAC 2015, I will have current certification for Youth Protection Training.
11. I will wear my full field uniform during meals, evening shows, and when other events request or require it. I understand that this includes proper scout pants.

13. I will carry with me to NOAC any medications that are prescribed in my name on a regular basis and disclose all medical conditions for my own safety and the safety of the Contingent. 14. I agree that any violation of the Contingent or NOAC policies may result in my immediate dismissal from the delegation and I agree to bear the cost of return transportation as may be determined by the Lodge.
