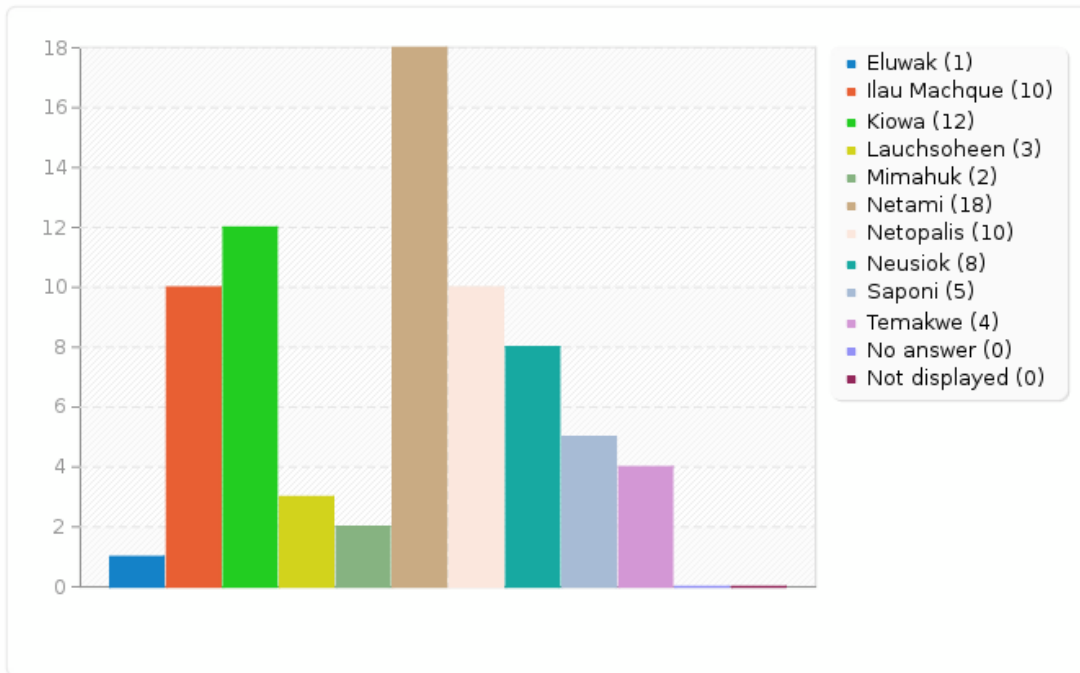

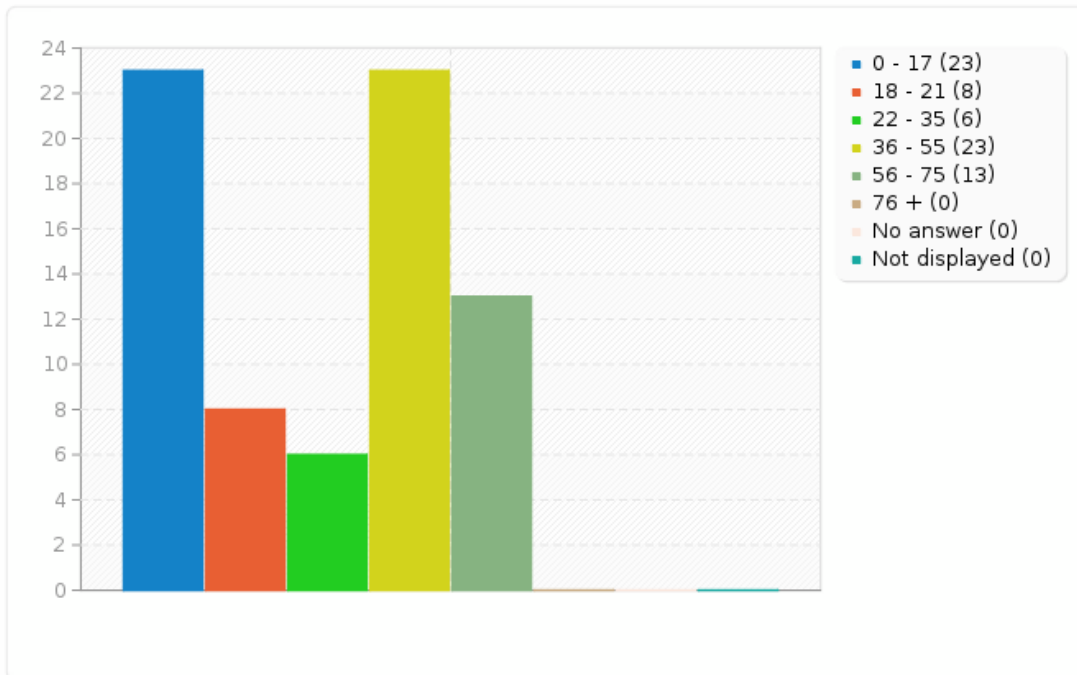

Please select your age range



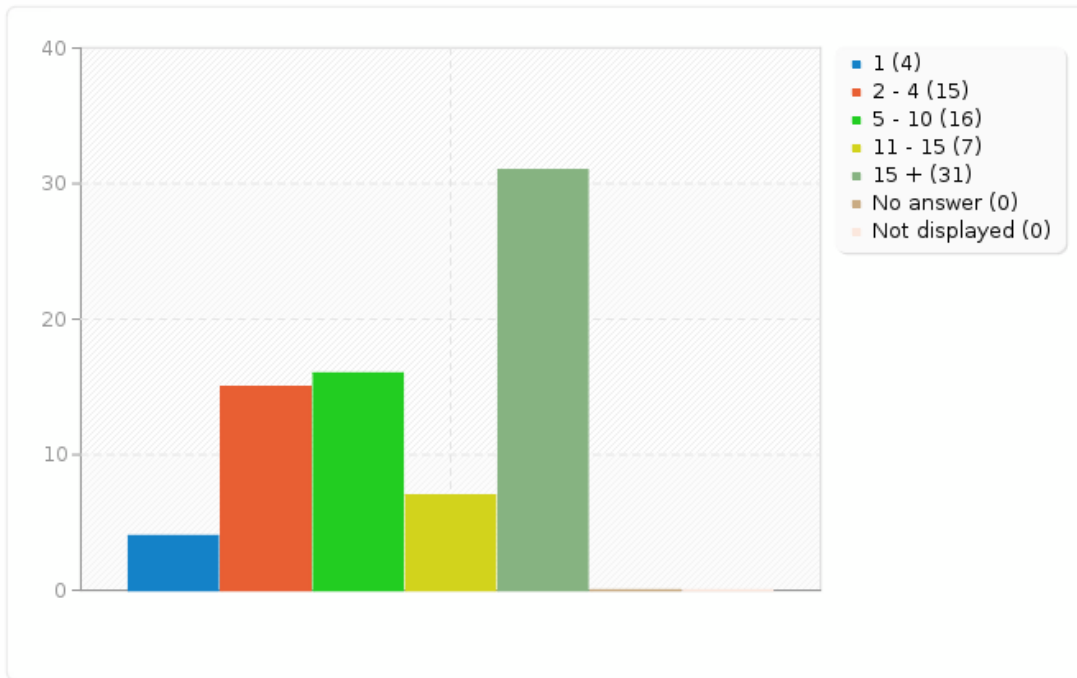

How many Lodge events have you attended in the past?



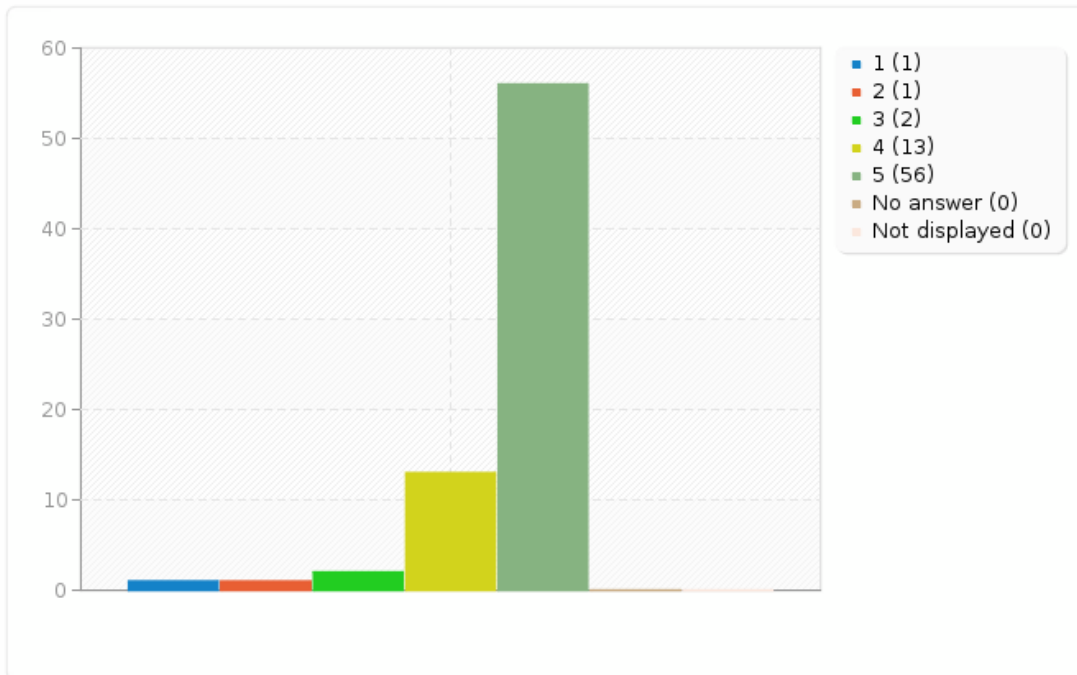

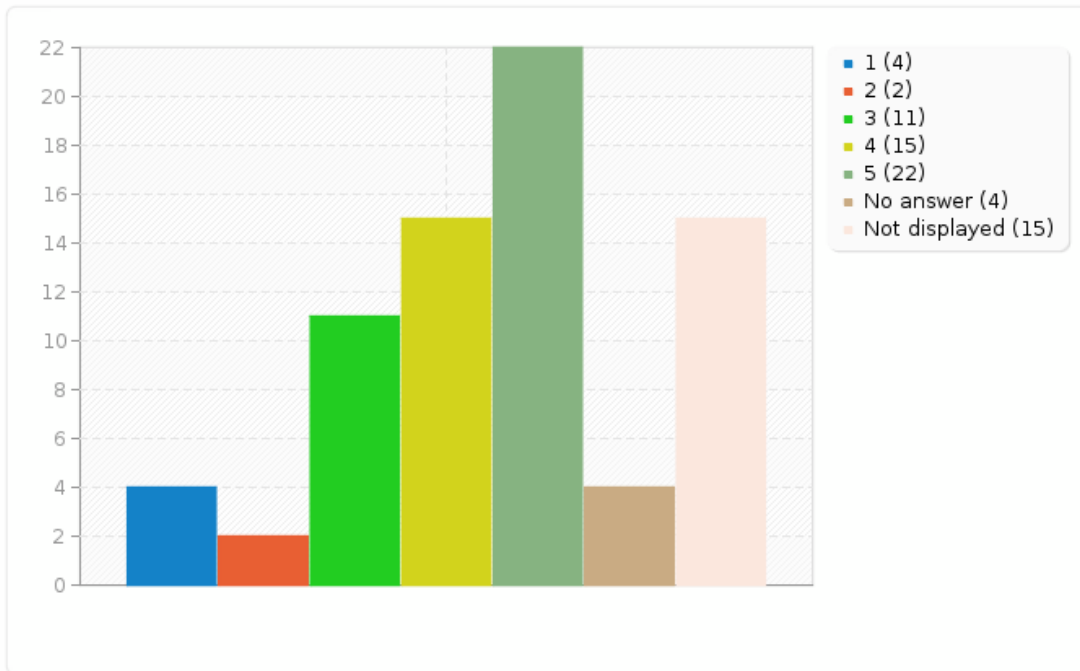

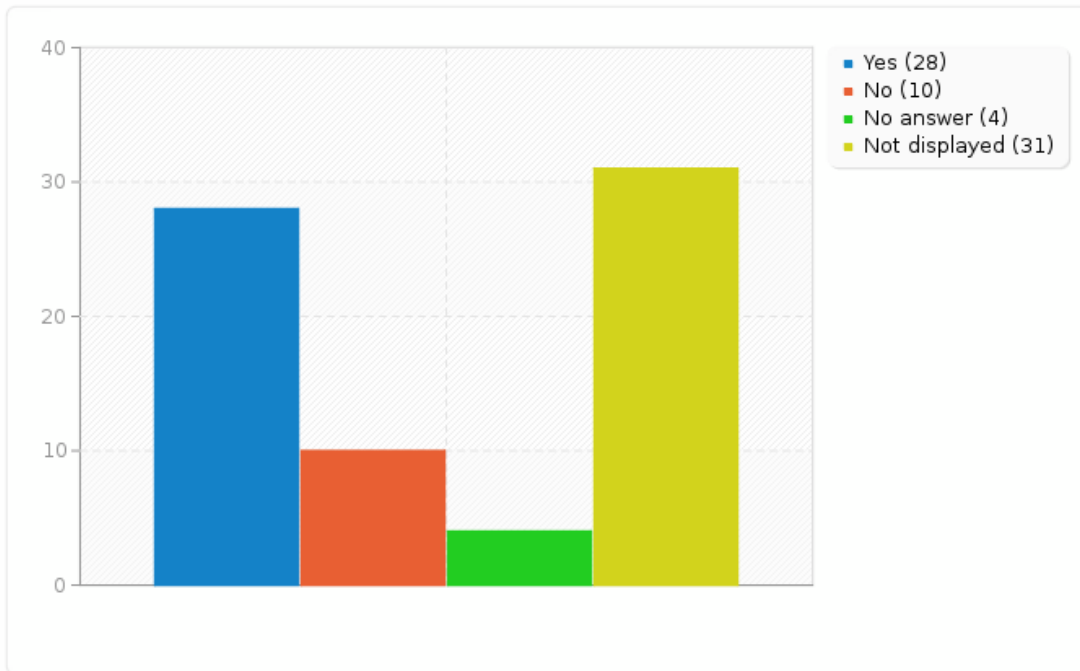

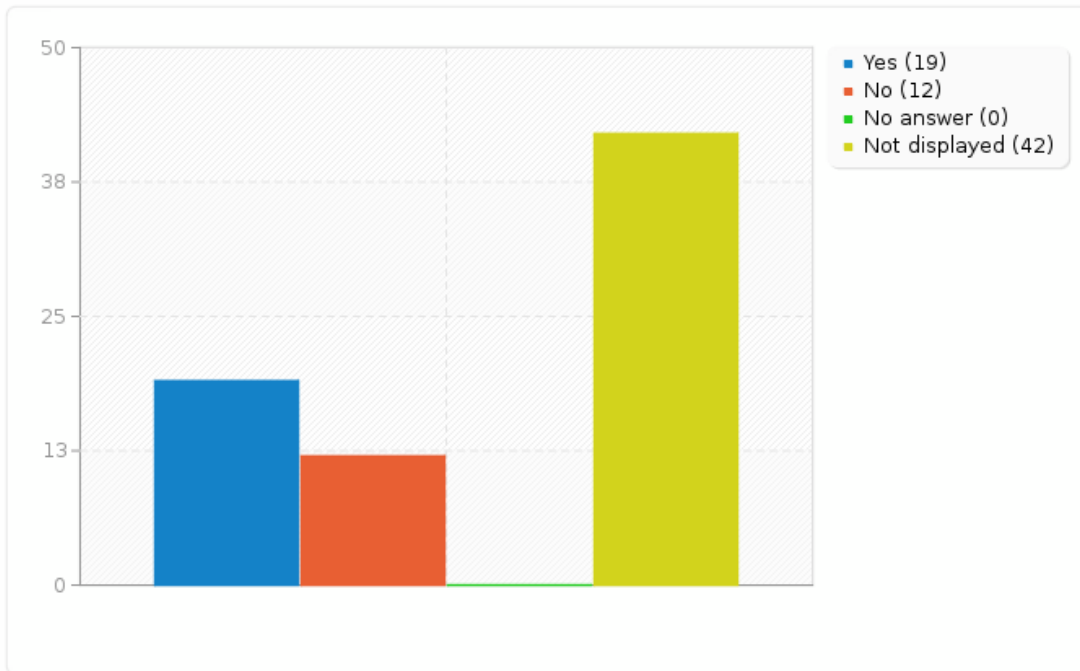

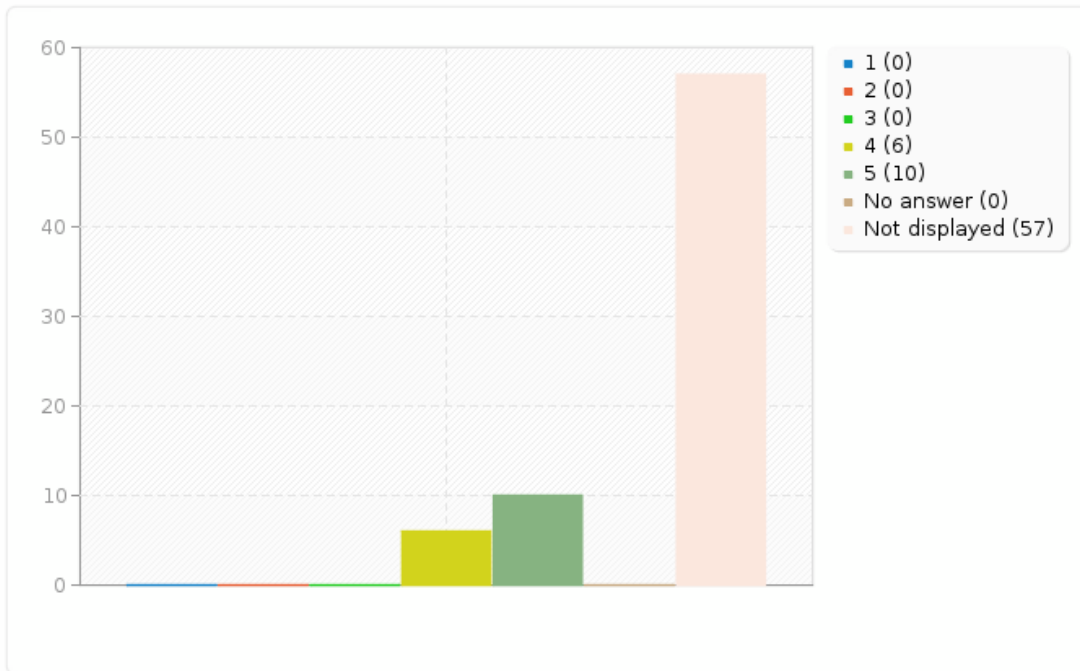

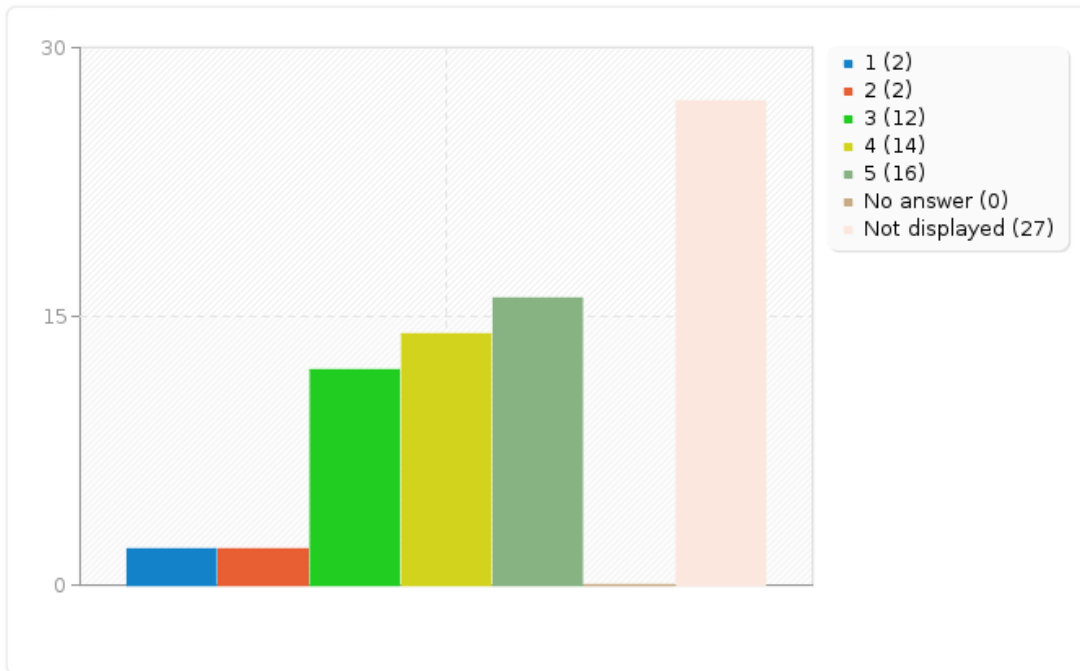
