Order of the Arrow Beginnings

The Order of the Arrow was founded in 1915 at Treasure Island, a Boy Scout camp located in the Delaware River, which was run by the Philadelphia Area Council. The Order's founders were E. Urner Goodman and Carroll A. Edson. This honor camper society spread slowly over the next twenty years.

The OA reached North Carolina in 1933 when Frank Braden became Scout Executive of Greensboro Area Council. He was a charter member of Cherokee Lodge 50 in Alabama. He brought the OA to Camp Graystone that summer. This lodge was initially listed as Graystone Lodge, but in 1935 the group chose the name Tali Taktaki Lodge and was assigned number 70. The members of Tali Taktaki lodge helped install new lodges across North Carolina and in Georgia and Florida.

Area 8, Area H and Area I - 1940s

As the OA grew the national organization began to group lodges geographically. In 1938 lodges in NC, SC, GA, and FL were part of Area 8. In 1940 Area 8 became Area H. With the addition of new lodges across the country the OA reorganized in 1942. The NC lodges became Area I. NC OA members first gathered at the 1941 Carolina Jubilee held in Chapel Hill. In 1942 a National Meeting of the OA was scheduled to be held at UNC – Chapel Hill, but with the beginning of World War II that event was canceled. Tali Taktaki invited local lodges to a gathering at Camp Graystone. This was the first multi-lodge function in NC. In 1944 the National Lodge suggested areas begin holding annual conferences for training, competition, and fellowship. North Carolina Fellowships were held in the fall of the late 1940s. The first area memorabilia was issued at these events.


Area 6A - 1950 - 1973

In the early 1900s as the Boy Scouts of America developed into a nationwide organization which was divided into twelve regions. These regions followed the alignment of the Federal Reserve System and were numbered from 1 to 12. Florida, Georgia, South and North Carolina made up Region 6. In 1948 the OA became the official honor society of the BSA, the eight lodges in eastern and central NC were grouped as Area A of Region 6. The area held events called <u>Area 6A Fellowships</u> from 1952 to 1973.







To commemorate the end of Area 6A a special "lame duck" patch was issued in 1973. It listed the lodges that had spent the previous twenty-five years together.

Section SE-3A - 1974 - 1981

In 1972 the BSA reorganized the region alignment. The twelve original regions were reduced to six. The 17 councils of North and South Carolina became Area 3 of the Southeast Region. Due to its size the area was divided into sections A and B. The eight lodges of Area 6A remained together and became known as Section SE-3A. The annual fellowship event was now called a "Conclave".

The History of Section SR-7B Through Patches Section SE-7 – 1982 - 1993

In 1981 the BSA changed the territory of the Southeast Region with councils in Maryland, Delaware, and Washington, DC transferring to the Northeast Region. The Southeast Region changed its section alignment. Three western NC lodges joined the eight lodges of SE-3A to form the new Section SE-7. Since the new section included 11 North Carolina lodges the section chose the nickname for its annual event as the "Old North State".

The History of Section SR-7B Through Patches Section SR-7 – 1994 - 1997

In 1992 the BSA reorganized from six regions to four. North Carolina became part of the Southern Region. The lodges from SE-7 were joined by four lodges from Virginia and renamed Section SR-7. The name "ONS Conclave" was dropped and a new name was adopted. The annual event was called the "Cardinal Conclave".

The History of Section SR-7B Through Patches Chapter Chief Patches

During Conclaves from 2011 – 2019 Chapter Chiefs were invited to a special luncheon on Saturday. They met visiting National officers and heard inspirational messages about their role in the Order.

Each design is silkscreened on felt and the colors used reflect the school colors of that year's Section Chief. Approximately 100 patches were issued each year.



Very Important Arrowman (VIA) Patches

During conclaves held in the 1990s-2000s a luncheon was held on Saturday for VIAs. Typically each lodge sent their lodge chief and their youngest youth to attend the event. They received one of these patches.






